To become a member of the Alliance

STEP 1. Decide which option suits you best

Option 1 Join an existing Group. If you live near one of the existing Member Groups in the region, you can join this group. The annual membership to join a group is varied between groups; it ranges between \$10 - \$40 per household.

Option 2 Become an Individual (associate) member of the S.E.A. Your membership to the Alliance will be reviewed annually. The annual membership fee with the S.E.A. is \$10 per household (inc. GST) to cover insurance and administration costs.

Either type of Membership will enable you to attend all volunteering & networking events held by the SEA or SEA's member groups, i.e. — an event hosted by one of our member groups. Financial members also receive either an electronic or hard copy of the National Landcare Magazine quarterly. Membership also makes you eligible to apply for funding with our group for projects that align with our group aims.
